2006 Annual Scholarship Awarding Ceremony

The annual scholarship awarding ceremony for 2006 was held on September 2 at Sri Sudassanaramaya, Battaramulla, Sri Lanka, from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. This ceremony was presided by our Patron and Advisor, Venerable Dr. Mirisse Dhammika, with the participation of 77 new scholarship students, their parents, some of the scholarship sponsors and other well wishers of the foundation. The chief guest for the occasion was Mr. Upali Gunasekara - Principal of Royal College, Colombo.

Out of the 77 scholarships awarded, 60 were for Grade 12 students while the remaining 17 were memorial scholarships for first year university students.

Scholarship award certificates and study packs were distributed to all new scholarship recipients. The expenses of the award ceremony, including lunch and refreshments for all the participants have been borne by Mr. Sudu Vatagodakumbura, Vice President of the SLCSF.

We thank all the students and their parents for participation; after travelling long distances from remote villages and cities in some cases. We also thank the scholarship sponsors who participated and awarded certificates to the students they have sponsored. Our thanks also go to Venerable Dhammika, the chief quest Mr. Upali Gunasekara, our Sri Lankan Coordinator - Mrs. Seetha Goonetilleke and all other supporters in organizing this successful event. New Grade 12 Scholarship Awards for 2006

This year, we have awarded 60 scholarships for Grade 12 students. They were selected from several hundred applications received, based on their G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) examination results in 2006, income per family member and considering other special circumstances (such as, deceased parents). All these students have obtained at least eight A's in the G.C.E. (O/L) examination, while many of them have received an impressive, straight 10 A's!

Establishment of Wijayasena Kiriwattuduwa Memorial Scholarship Fund

Mrs. Seetha Goonetilleke – our Sri Lankan Coordinator, has established the "Wijayasena Kiriwattuduwa Memorial Scholarship Fund" for funding scholarships for first year university students in the medical faculty on an on-going basis, in memory of her beloved father, late Mr. Wijayasena Kiriwattuduwa, a retired school principal.

These scholarships provide Rs. 1000 per month for a period of one year to the selected students in Sri Lankan universities. This year, two scholarships have been awarded from this fund. We thank Mrs. Goonetilleke for her generosity in establishing this fund for helping financially our university students.

Memorial Scholarship Awards to University Students

This year, for the first time, 17 scholarships have been awarded to first year university students in the medical faculties.

A monthly award of Rs. 1000 is provided for one year to each of the selected students. The main selection criteria were the academic excellence of the student (based on the results of the G.C.E. Advanced Level examination) and the financial status of the student's family.
