One hundred thirty-three students from our 2017 batch of scholarship recipients have passed the GCE A/L (General Certificate of Education - Advanced Level) - 2019 Examination in all three subjects. **Nineteen** of them have passed with **straight 3A's** and are ranked in top positions in their respective districts. In addition, **25** students (44 in total) have secured grades for university admission. Most of them are expected to be admitted to various universities in Sri Lanka. ## Letter from Shanaka Kalupahana (Past Scholarship Receipt)

---

I am Shanaka Kalupahana, a past recipient of a scholarship awarded by the Sri Lanka-Canada Scholarship Foundation. I am from Ambalangoda and I did my G.C.E. Ordinary Level (O/L) & Advanced Level (A/L) studies at St. Aloysius' College in Galle. I have passed the GCE O/L with 9 A's and then the GCE A/L with 3 A's and C for English. Currently, I am in my final year at the Faculty of Medicine - University of Ruhuna. I am so happy that the Sri Lanka-Canada Scholarship Foundation assigned me to Mrs. Chandra Stokes as my sponsor. Her monthly scholarship payments helped me to continue my Advanced Level years in 2009-2011.

My dream was to get the admission to a medical college. Unfortunately, I was unable to get enough marks to qualify for a medical college with my 1st attempt. Therefore, I sat for the A/L exam again in 2012. When I asked my sponsor to help me for another year to fulfil my dream to be a doctor, without any hesitation, she continued to support my tutorial classes. When I got my results in January 2013, I knew that I did my best to open the door for my future as well as for my family. I am very fortunate that she had agreed to help me with the expenses during the six years of studies at the medical college. That brings eight years of additional financial assistance that I have received from Mrs. Chandra Stokes. All the money that I had received after completion of the first two years of the SLCSF scholarship was her personal contributions towards my education. I believe she must be the longest sponsor who had helped a student for ten long years. When I think about it, she must be one of my mothers in my previous life. Therefore, I won't say she is my sponsor anymore, I would say she is my second mother. I met her once when she was in Sri Lanka. I know she has a son, but I know she treats me as her own son.

My family consists of 4 members - my parents, younger sister and myself. We had plenty of financial issues since my childhood. Our home was being built partially and my father is a casual worker and his work mainly depended on the weather. As we grew older, our needs progressively went up & up. It was severely intensified when my sister got the admission to the University of Kelaniya. Currently, she is at the final year of her Mass Media degree program. My A/L tutorial fees and her university expenses were too much of a burden for my father since there was no other income. Even though it was a huge weight on my father's shoulder, he did his best to fulfil our needs. When I got the news that I had been selected to receive a scholarship from the Sri Lanka-Canada Scholarship Foundation, there is no need to say how relieved I was and my father as well.

When I passed my G.C.E. O/L exam with flying colours (9 A's), our Justice of Peace (at that time) in our village sent me a message to come to his house. He was an avid reader of the daily newspaper. When I visited him, he showed me the advertisement in the paper about the scholarship application from the SLCSF and asked me to apply for it. It was the year 2009. Unfortunately, he passed away recently and he has my utmost gratitude for helping me to get to the place where I am now. I will never forget him.

Thank you, Mrs. Stokes, and thanks to the Foundation, it took off some of the unbearable heavy load of weight on our family. It was very admirable that my scholarship had been allocated only for two years, but it extended unconditionally by Mrs. Stokes to the end of my final year at the medical college. I remember, she taught me a lifelong lesson - "if you want to help someone, you don't have to be rich". She was not limited to those words, she proved it too. Once she sent me my annual expenses from the money that she had earned by looking after one of her neighbours' dog while they were on a month-long vacation. On that day, when I read the letter that came with the money, I got so emotional and realized how generous she is & I do admire her very much. Also, I still can remember, at times, she was my English teacher.



Because, she corrected my spellings and grammar in my emails. It helped me to pay attention to my writing and to improve my writing skills, as well as my confidence.

Finally, I humbly request all members & non-members who read this letter, please help our Sri Lankan children, who are so gifted but struggling with financial difficulties & miss their opportunities for higher education. They need your help. I personally know some of the students that save their Mahapola scholarship money and work part-time to help their poor parents and families & jeopardising their university studies. Also, I should never forget and be thankful for our free education system in Sri Lanka. It is the main root which gives us a boost to build our knowledge, making a path to our progress. I also want to thank for the generosity and kindness and volunteer work of the administrative executives, and all past and present sponsors of SLCSF who together help our motherland not expecting anything in return. You are making a huge, positive difference in a student's life like myself. I am hoping to do the same in the near future. I am so proud & very excited about a journey that I am going to start as a Doctor to provide medical care & spread humanity to all my Sri Lankans at my level best.

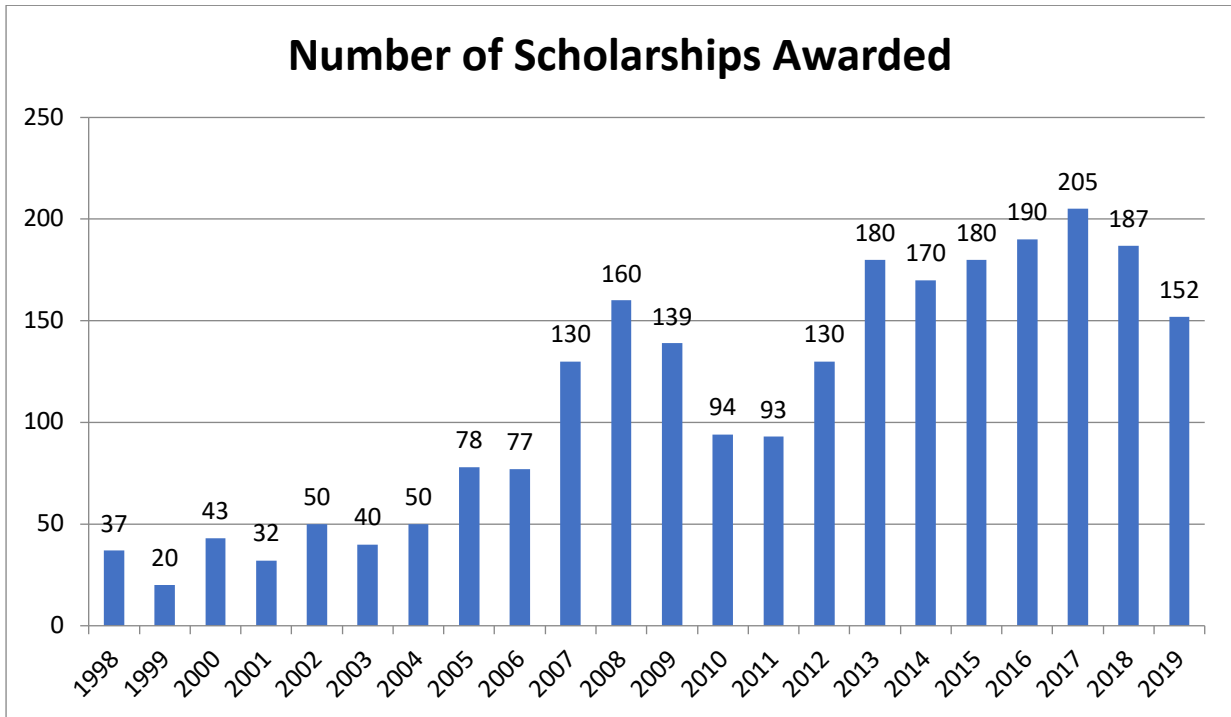
